LCVP – Optional Leaving Cert subject

LCVP (also known as Link Modules) is an extra subject that we offer to our 5th year students. Students can gain extra Leaving Cert points by taking LCVP as an extra subject in their Leaving Certificate exams.

In last 3 years over 80% of those who did LCVP and went on to college used it as one of their 6 subjects, when applying for a college place.

LCVP is a Senior Cycle Programme of the Department of Education and Skills, designed to give a strong vocational dimension to the Leaving Certificate (established). The programme combines the virtues of academic study with a new and dynamic focus on self-directed learning, enterprise, work and the community. Young people taking the LCVP have a unique opportunity to develop their interpersonal, vocational and technological skills. These skills are equally relevant to the needs of those preparing for further education, seeking employment or planning to commence their own business sometime in the future.

As part of the Leaving Certificate Vocational Programme all students are required to prepare 6 typed assignments over the course of a year and a half. These documents are then assembled in a Portfolio of work that is examined, by the examiner, as one of their Leaving Certificate subjects (LCVP).

Assessment

Assessment is at a common level (no higher or ordinary levels)

students sit a terminal examination paper, representing 40% of the total marks, at the end of the final year of the LCVP

students submit a portfolio of coursework, representing 60% of total marks, developed over the two years of the programme and submitted at the end of the final year of the LCVP

grades awarded for the Link Modules are Distinction (80-100%), Merit (65-79%) and Pass (50-64%).

ASSESSMENT OF THE LINK MODULES
