

Provisional Leaving Cert Results 2021

The provisional results of the 2021 Leaving Certificate are due to issue on Friday 3 September. We have compiled some information that may be of use.

Accessing Results

Unfortunately, due to the very high rate of community infection of COVID-19, like last year, the school will not be able to allow students to come to school to collect their provisional results.

Leaving Certificate, Leaving Certificate Vocational Programme and Leaving Certificate Applied candidates will have access to their provisional Leaving Certificate results on the Candidate Self Service Portal at 10 am on Friday 3 September. Candidates can view their results and will also be able to print a statement of their provisional results.

School Supports for Candidates

Bridgetown College will provide support to candidates in an appropriate way on the day, through enabling candidates to come to the school if they wish at a scheduled time, to meet with members of the Student Support Team such as Guidance Counsellors or Year Head. The arrangements for this will be in line with public health advice, the schools COVID-19 Response Plan and the school's visitor policy. Former students who attend the school for a scheduled visit will be required to respect physical distancing requirements and to behave in a responsible way. Gathering groups of students in one venue is not allowed on the school grounds. This is in order to minimise the risk of COVID-19 for staff, students, families and the wider community. The health and safety of the entire school community must be considered.

Candidate Supports

The wellbeing of the candidates who receive Leaving Certificate results will be supported through a number of additional measures.
